

SECTION VI: Development of Inpatient Psychiatric Treatment

A. Characteristics of the service area plan target population to be moved from HSH into the community between 2005 and 2010as part of SAP Goal # 1:

On July 1, 2004 the HSH bed census will be reduced to 264 beds. According to demographic data 147 consumers have been in the care of HSH in excess of two years. Of this group 31 are on voluntary commitments, all are white except for 23 non-Hispanic blacks, 1 Hispanic black, 6 Hispanic whites, and 2 Asians. Of those on 201's (Voluntary Admissions) only two are on discharge oriented units and one is on E3W. All of the 147 have Axis I disorders of schizophrenia except for:

11 - Bipolar; 6-Personality changes due to General Medical Condition; 1 - Psychotic Disorder due to General Medical Condition; 1 - Obsessive Compulsive Disorder; 3 - Impulse Control Disorders; 2 - Dementias; 1 - Psychotic Disorder, NOS; and 1 - paraphilia. Of the 7 with disorders related to general medical conditions, 4 have histories of Brain Trauma.

Of the 2+ year LOS group, all but 6 are from the general service area. Of these 6, two are 201's. Thirty-eight (38) are female.

Within the entire HSH, 165 (duplicated number) have Axis 2 diagnoses: 36 have Personality Disorders, 28 have other Conditions; 24 have early onset disorders; 17 have anxiety disorders; and, 5 have sexual and other gender identity disorders.
