RESOLUTION NO. 89-16

CUMBERLAND COUNTY AGRICULTURAL CONSERVATION EASEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, over 1,100 farms produced nearly \$80 million in agricultural products in 1987, making agriculture a leading industry in Cumberland County; and

WHEREAS, Cumberland County is currently losing an average of over 2,200 acres of productive farmland a year; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has determined that Cumberland County should participate in the Commonwealth's Agricultural Conservation Easement Program as one means to slow the unacceptably high level of farmland loss; and

WHEREAS, a requirement of Pennsylvania Act 43, P.L. 128, No. 43, the Agricultural Area Security Law, as amended December 14, 1988, P.L. 1202, No. 149, is that counties must appoint a County Agricultural Land Preservation Board to administer the County Farmland Protection Program.

NOW THEREFORE, it is resolved that the Agricultural Land Preservation Board is hereby appointed to administer the Agricultural Conservation Easement Program for Cumberland County.


