

BOARD OF ELECTIONS

May 28, 2013

The Cumberland County Board of Elections met on Tuesday, May 28, 2013, 10:00 a.m., Bureau of Elections, 310 Allen Road, Carlisle, PA. Present was Commissioner Barbara Cross, Commissioner Jim Hertzler and Commissioner Gary Eichelberger; Ed Schorpp, Solicitor; Acting Chief Clerk Joanne Burkhart; Janet Walter, Paralegal, Solicitor's Office; Penny Brown, Bethany Salzarulo, Bureau of Elections; Mark Adams, IMTO.

Commissioner Cross called the meeting to order. Roll Call was taken: Commissioners Cross, Hertzler and Eichelberger were present.

Commissioner Cross asked if there was any public comment. There was none.

Commissioner Hertzler moved to approve the meeting minutes of May 1, 2013. Commissioner Eichelberger seconded the motion and the motion unanimously carried. Commissioner Cross moved to approve the meeting minutes of May 16, 2013. Commissioner Eichelberger seconded the motion and the motion carried with Commissioner Hertzler abstaining because he was absent at this meeting.

Penny Brown presented for the Board's approval the report of the Provisional Ballot Determination. Ms. Brown reported there were 54 total Provisional Ballots submitted. Three votes were counted completely, six were partially counted and 45 were not counted. The 45 uncounted Provisional Ballots were third-party registrants who are not eligible to vote in the Primary Election. The Provisional Ballot receipts are imprinted with a bar code so the voter can check on the Department of State's website for an explanation on the status of their ballot and the reason their ballot was counted or not counted. A brief discussion ensued. Commissioner Eichelberger moved to approve the Provisional Ballot Determination (see attached). Commissioner Hertzler seconded the motion and it unanimously carried.

Penny Brown presented for the Board's approval the Cumulation of Write-in Votes. There was a question regarding one vote for Lylis York and one vote for Larissa Wright for Lemoyne Borough Mayor, Democratic. These two votes could not be counted because the name of this individual was incorrect. The correct spelling is Larissa York. Ms. York received 90 votes. Another question was regarding an individual named Ped Young, Jr. who received one vote. The correct name of the individual running for Lower Allen Township Commissioner, Democratic is Peddrick Young or Ped Young, Sr. Mr. Young received 16 votes. There was a brief discussion regarding the Lower Allen Township Commissioner and Row Office write-in votes. Commissioner Eichelberger moved to approve the Cumulation of Write-In Votes (see attached). Commissioner Hertzler seconded the motion and it unanimously carried.

Penny Brown requested the Board to Submit the Unofficial Results to the State and to lay the results on view. Ms. Brown said these results will lay on view starting today for one week. There are three Military ballots that have yet to be counted and this will take place tomorrow at 9:00 a.m., May 29, 2013. There is a Board of Elections meeting scheduled for 1:15 p.m., May 29, 2013 in the Commissioners' Hearing Room. Commissioner Eichelberger moved to authorize

Submission of the Unofficial Results to the State and to Lay on View. Commissioner Hertzler seconded the motion and it unanimously carried.

Penny Brown presented for the Board's consideration the Military/Overseas Postage Reimbursement to the Bureau of Elections in the amount of \$138.60. Commissioner Hertzler moved to approve the Military/Overseas Postage Reimbursement. Commissioner Eichelberger seconded the motion and it unanimously carried.

Commissioner Cross asked if there was other business before the Board. Penny Brown stated that the 4:00 p.m. meeting previously scheduled for this afternoon will not need to be held.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting adjourned at 10:17 a.m.
