### ***Cumberland County Commissioners Approve Nursing Home Rehabilitation Center Project***

**Cumberland County, Pennsylvania-** Today during their regular public meeting the Cumberland County Board of Commissioners, by a two to one vote, awarded the bids that will formally begin a planned renovation project for a portion of the Claremont Nursing and Rehabilitation Center (CNRC). The purpose of these renovations is to create a new rehabilitation facility that will serve the increased demand for short term and long term rehabilitation.

While CNRC currently provides rehabilitation services, the new facility will allow CNRC to further expand and improve services offered and in turn further build upon the quality care that has come to be expected at CNRC. The project is slated to begin in March and expected to take approximately 8 months to complete. Upon completion of this project and opening of the new state of the art rehabilitation center, CNRC will be able to offer a more comprehensive line of healthcare services required by the County's senior citizens.

CNRC, a CMS 5 Star Facility, is a community-based nursing and short term rehabilitation facility with an open admissions policy. The facility hosts 290 beds and strives to provide state of the art therapeutic nursing care for a variety of needs. For more information on CNRC visit
