***Cumberland County Juvenile Probation  
Releases 2013 Juvenile Court Report Card***

**Cumberland County, Pennsylvania-** Cumberland County Juvenile Probation recently released their Juvenile Court Report Card for 2013. This annual report highlights victim restitution rates and community service hours completed by juveniles, in addition to other aspects of the work of the Juvenile Probation Department. The data in this report has been drawn from 229 cases closed out from juvenile probation supervision in 2013, and does not include cases that are still or were still active at the close of 2013.

The 2013 report shows that 98.1 % of juveniles ordered to pay restitution to their victims completed their obligation in full. This is a nearly 5% increase compared to the previous three years. In total, this accounted for \$28,248.29 collected for victims of juvenile crime. The report also addresses the community service obligation completion rate, which was at 97.6% with over 8,500 hours served. In 2013, 92.6% of the juvenile offenders in Cumberland County also successfully completed their period of supervision without a new offense.

Cumberland County Juvenile Probation, under the direction and guidance of the Cumberland County Juvenile Court, provides services to youth that fall within the jurisdiction of the Juvenile Court. Probation duties are governed by the Juvenile Act and the Juvenile Court Procedural Rules of Pennsylvania.
