***Cumberland County to Host Ribbon Cutting Ceremony
for New Enck's Mill Bridge***

Cumberland County, PA- The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners and Herbert, Rowland & Grubic, Inc. would like to announce a ceremonial ribbon cutting at the Enck's Mill Bridge in Dickinson Township on October 23, 2014 at 1:30 pm. The Enck's Mill Bridge was recently replaced as part of the Cumberland County Bridge Capital Improvement Program.

The bridge's \$650,000 construction cost was funded using proceeds from the Pennsylvania Marcellus Shale Legacy Fund which provides funding to counties for replacement and repair of "at-risk bridges." The original single lane bridge was built in 1905 and was posted with an 8-ton weight limit that prevented heavier vehicles from using the bridge. The new two-lane bridge has no weight limit and allows the safe passage of school buses, snow plows, emergency response vehicles, trash trucks, and agricultural equipment. A fisherman's parking area that improves public access to the Yellow Breeches Creek was integrated into the bridge's design through a partnership with the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission.

Cumberland County owns and is responsible for 28 bridges, nine of which are jointly owned with York County. Over the next six years, Cumberland County has proposed a \$14 million improvement project to its bridges using Federal, State and County funds.
