

BOARD OF ELECTIONS Minutes

October 30, 2014

10:00 AM – COMMISSIONERS' HEARING ROOM

Present: Commissioner Cross, Hertzler, and Eichelberger. Larry Thomas, Chief Clerk; Sandy Moyle, Deputy Chief Clerk/Meetings Manager; Keith Brenneman, Solicitor; Roxanne Lehman, Paralegal; Mark Adams, IMTO.

Call to Order: Commissioner Cross called the meeting to order.

Roll Call: Commissioner Cross, Hertzler and Eichelberger were present.

Public Comment: None

Minutes Approval: Commissioner Hertzler moved to approve the minutes of the October 9, 2014. Commissioner Eichelberger seconded the motion and it unanimously carried.

Appointments: Penny Brown stated that these are paid positions that need approved by the Board and all individuals have been trained. Commissioner Eichelberger had received a letter from Jane Graham. Her concerns are that there are too many paid poll workers at her precinct and one does not reside within Newville Borough. Penny Brown understands her concerns but Newville Borough is following what the Code states as far as how many workers and what Code permits as far as residency. Commissioner Eichelberger requested that a response be sent to Jane Graham addressing her concerns. Commissioner Hertzler questioned the individual appointed to Newville but not a Newville Resident. Penny Brown stated that this is allowed five days prior to Election Day and the total of workers need is based on registration figures. Commissioner Hertzler moved to appoint Individuals to fill vacancies occurring within 5 days of the Election. Commissioner Eichelberger seconded the motion and it unanimously carried.

Approval of Machine Inspectors: Penny Brown stated that the number of inspectors is determined by the number of precincts and there are 664 machines that need inspected. Commissioner Eichelberger moved to approve the number of machine inspectors per precinct. Commissioner Hertzler seconded the motion and it unanimously carried.

Approval of Pool of Poll Workers: Commissioner Hertzler moved to approve the pool of poll workers. Commissioner Cross seconded the motion and it unanimously carried.

Approval of Student Workers: Penny Brown stated that all students have been trained. Commissioner Eichelberger moved to approve the student workers. Commissioner Hertzler seconded the motion and it unanimously carried.

Other Business: Solicitor Brenneman mentioned that if the Commissioners plan to run for re-election, they cannot be on the Board of Elections. The Commissioners will need to choose another Board member and submit a letter to the President Judge for approval. Then a reorg. meeting will need to be held.

ADJOURN: There being no further business to come before the Board the meeting adjourned.
