**Cumberland County, PA**- March 7-11 is National Weights and Measures Week. One of the oldest professions of modern times, the role of Weights and Measures departments is vital to economies worldwide, as it ensures fairness between consumer and seller.

The County Vector Control/Weights and Measures Office is responsible for the annual testing and inspection of commercial weighing and measuring devices including:

- Gas, Diesel, E85, & Bio Diesel Fuel Pumps
- Small and Medium Capacity Scales
- Precious Metal Scales
- Shipping/Parcel Scales
- UPC Scanners, Mulch / Tanbark & Firewood are tested based on consumer complaints
- Parking Meters tested every 3-5 years (Carlisle, Newville, & Shippensburg Boroughs)

Cumberland County Weights & Measures is using a newly designed Approval Sticker for 2016, complete with a QR code linking the consumer to real time inspection records and results.
