**CLAREMONT NURSING & REHABILITATION CENTER
TO HOST COMMUNITY EVENT - FELINE ADOPTION FESTIVAL**

Cumberland County, PA – The Claremont Nursing & Rehabilitation Center (CNRC) located at 1000 Claremont Road, Carlisle, plans to hold a Feline Festival Rescue Event on Saturday, March 12, 2016 from 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. Six rescue groups will be on-site with cats and kittens for adoption. The event will also offer the community an opportunity to bring both dogs and cats (in carriers) to receive low cost vaccines. Vaccines are provided courtesy of Nobody's Cats Foundation, a non-profit organization that promotes the adoption of Trap Neuter Return (TNR) as the preferred strategy for humanely stabilizing and reducing free-roaming domestic feline populations.

In addition to the low cost vaccine clinic, several vendors will be on-site during the event offering a variety of products for sale including Pampered Chef, Tastefully Simple, Thirty One Gifts, Scentsy, and local Girl Scout Daisies will have boxed cookies available for purchase. The program also includes musical entertainment. All proceeds will go to the rescues. Monetary donations or any cat toys, cat food, cat litter, old blankets, sheets, and towels will be accepted and distributed to the rescue groups.
