17th Annual 50+ Expo To Be Held In October

Cumberland County, PA- The Cumberland County 50+ Expo, presented by On-Line Publishers, Inc. and sponsored in part by the Office of Aging and Community Services will take place on Wednesday, October 19, 2016 from 9:00 a.m.- 2:00 p.m. at the Carlisle Expo Center located at 100 K Street in Carlisle. This is the 17th year for the free 50+ Expo offering valuable information to baby boomers, seniors, and their caregivers. The event features more than 90 exhibitors displaying products and services in the areas of travel, housing, medical services, nutrition, home improvements, finances, healthcare options and more. Free health screenings and seminars will be offered along with door prizes and entertainment.

The Expo will also have a medication collection drop box available. Attendees are encouraged to bring with them unused and unwanted medications for safe disposal. There are over 20 medication collection boxes at various locations in the County that are part of an ongoing effort to combat the opiate and heroin abuse in Cumberland County. To date in 2016, Cumberland County has collected and disposed over 8,000 pounds of prescription medications under the jurisdiction of the Cumberland County District Attorney.

Disposal Guidelines

- All pharmaceutical drugs that are being disposed of need to be in a sealed container such as the original bottle or a zip-lock bag. They may NOT be disposed of loosely.
- Liquid pharmaceuticals should remain in the original container.
- Personal information should be removed or blotted out with a permanent marker.
- Prescription and over-the-counter solid medications, tablets and capsules, liquid medications, inhalers, creams, ointments, nasal sprays and pet medications are accepted.
