Register to Vote by October 10

Cumberland County, Pa. – The Cumberland County Bureau of Elections reminds all residents that in order to vote in the Tuesday, November 7 general election, you must be registered by October 10, 2017. New registrations, or changes to existing registrations, may be completed via mail, online or in-person at the Cumberland County Elections office, 1601 Ritner Highway, Suite 201, Carlisle.

Voter registrations can also be completed at a local Department of Motor Vehicles office when renewing a driver's license, or at various government agencies, including the Department of Public Welfare, Health, Labor and Industry, the County Clerk of Orphans Court and all armed forces recruitment centers.

Cumberland County residents who will be out of the area on election day, but still wish to vote, may do so by requesting an absentee ballot. All absentee ballot requests must be received by Tuesday, October 31, 2017.
