Cumberland County Commissioners Applaud CAT Board Action

Cumberland County, Pa. – The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners today applauded the Capital Area Transit (CAT) board for their decision to contract with rabbitransit for management operations.

In a joint statement, the Commissioners said: “We fully support and thank the CAT board, which today unanimously took steps toward a regionalized, consolidated transportation system. This action to contract management operations to rabbitransit is a positive step for the residents of Cumberland and Dauphin counties, and the City of Harrisburg.
