## ***Hertzler Bridge Closed After Damage from Vehicle Crash***

**Carlisle, Pa.** – Cumberland County closed [Hertzler Bridge](#) today due to damage from a recent crash. The County's bridge engineer inspected the bridge early this morning and recommended the closure until repairs can be made. The County will release more details on repair plans and a reopening date after a detailed inspection of the damage is completed.

The 122- year old steel truss Hertzler Bridge is on Creek Road and crosses the Conodoguinet Creek in West Pennsboro and Lower Frankford townships. The bridge sees an average daily traffic rate of 460 vehicles and is weight posted to eight tons. The County is planning a full rehabilitation of the bridge in 2019 and 2020.
