Tax Day is Coming **Send Your Income Tax Returns to the Correct Office**

Carlisle, Pa. – With tax day right around the corner, the Cumberland County Commissioners remind all residents to make sure they are sending their local income tax returns to the correct office. Local income tax returns should be sent to the Cumberland County Tax Bureau, 21 Waterford Drive, Suite 201, Mechanicsburg. Despite its name, the Cumberland County Tax Bureau is not a County government office. Cumberland County government does not levy income tax, and does not accept or process local income tax returns.

Local income taxes are levied by many of the County's school districts and municipalities; not County government. The Cumberland County Tax Bureau, which is not a County government office, is operated by the school districts and municipalities.

Income tax returns sent to any Cumberland County Government office will be returned to the sender and not filed.
