Register to Vote by April 16th

Carlisle, Pa. – The Cumberland County Bureau of Elections reminds all residents that in order to vote in the Tuesday, May 15th primary election, you must be registered by Monday, April 16, 2018. New registrations or changes to existing registrations, may be completed via mail, online or in-person at the Cumberland County Elections office, 1601 Ritner Highway, Suite 201, Carlisle.

Voter registrations can also be completed at a local Department of Motor Vehicles office when renewing a driver's license, or at various government agencies, including the Department of Public Welfare, Health, Labor and Industry, the County Clerk of Orphans Court and all armed forces recruitment centers. Cumberland County residents who will be out of the area on primary election day, but still wish to vote, may do so by requesting an absentee ballot. All absentee ballot requests must be received by Tuesday, May 8, 2018.

Cumberland County's Bureau of Elections maintains voter registrations, conducts County elections, prepares official ballots and trains Election Day polling staff. The office is committed to providing clear and transparent voter services to the people of Cumberland County.
