Commissioners Place Preliminary 2018/19 Fiscal Budget on View

Carlisle, Pa. – The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners approved placing the preliminary 2018/19 Fiscal Budget on public view today. Total revenue in the Fiscal Budget is \$94,472,474, which predominantly consists of Human Services funding. Grants from state and federal sources will cover 89% of the budget, or \$84,164,558. County subsidy and additional funding sources cover the remaining 11% of the budget. The County's Finance Department anticipates total expenses to be \$94,506,473.

The budget will remain on view in the Commissioners' Office and will be available online until June 4, 2018. The Fiscal Budget is scheduled for approval during the 2 p.m. June 4, 2018 Board of Commissioners meeting.
