Commissioners Adopt 2018/2019 Fiscal Budget

Carlisle, Pa. – The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners adopted the 2018/2019 Fiscal Budget on Monday during their public meeting. The Fiscal Budget totals \$94,472,474. Grants from state and federal sources will cover 89% of the budget, or \$84,164,558. County subsidy provides 6% of the funding, and the remainder comes from other funding sources. The County's Finance Department anticipates total expenses to be \$94,506,473. The Fiscal Departments will continue monitoring the State Budget and request adjustments when final allocations from the state are available.

Cumberland County operates under a Fiscal Budget and a Calendar Year Budget. The Fiscal Budget funds many of Cumberland County's Human Services departments and includes a significant amount of funding from the State and various grants. The Calendar Year Budget funds most of the non-human services departments for the County and is financed through the County's general fund.
