Local Resident Appointed to Drug & Alcohol Advisory Board

Carlisle, Pa. – The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners recently appointed Baylee Whitebread to the Cumberland Perry Drug and Alcohol Commission Community Advisory Board.

Whitebread previously served as a member of the Cumberland Perry Drug and Alcohol Commission Youth Advisory Board. As a member, he was on the Positive Messaging Committee, which focused on creating content that discouraged middle school and high school aged kids from trying drugs and alcohol. On the Advisory Board, he wants to find new programs that will help put an end to the opioid crisis and continue funding for rehabilitation programs.
