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***Claremont Nursing and Rehabilitation Center Awarded Long-Term Care Grant***

**Carlisle, Pa.** – Claremont Nursing and Rehabilitation Center (CNRC) is the proud recipient of a grant from the Pennsylvania Department of Human Services (DHS) in the amount of \$8,971 for their Multi-Sensory Environment, Heritage Harbor project.

Claremont Nursing and Rehabilitation Center was chosen as the recipient of the grant over 40 other applications received by the DHS from various skilled nursing facilities in PA.

The goal of Pennsylvania's Long-Term Care Grant Program is to facilitate the use of federally imposed Civil Money Penalty (CMP) funds for one-time, time-limited projects that support, protect, and benefit residents living in nursing facilities. This award will allow for specialized equipment and space to better serve Claremont's residents with Alzheimer's and other forms of dementia. The grant is for 18 months and may be extended for up to 36 months following evaluation of results.

First established in 1829, Claremont Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, named a five star facility by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, is a community-based skilled nursing and rehabilitation center with an open admissions policy. The 282-bed facility provides advanced therapeutic nursing care for a variety of needs, a state-of-the-art dementia unit and a dedicated short term rehab unit.
