Deputy Chief Clerk Sandy Moyle Appointed To Cumberland County Chief Clerk *Former Chief Clerk Steps Down Due to Family Medical Issues*

Carlisle PA – The Cumberland County Commissioners today appointed Deputy Chief Clerk Sandy Moyle to Chief Clerk/COO after accepting the resignation of Stephen Brayman, who stepped down due to ongoing family medical issues and the need to work closer to his father and daughter in Maryland. The commissioners agreed to the request, support Steve in his decision, and wish him and his family the best. Brayman began his position in Feb. 2018.

Moyle served as deputy chief clerk for the past four years and acting chief for 7 months, prior to Brayman joining the staff. Moyle worked for a district magistrate in Lewistown for 15 years and as senior associate for Public Financial Management in Harrisburg for 17 years.

As chief clerk, Moyle will manage the county's day-to-day operations within the guidelines set forth by the Pennsylvania County Code and the Board of Commissioners.
