Dog Licenses for 2019 are Now Available at the County Treasurer's Office

Carlisle, PA – If you own a dog, they need to have a current license. Cumberland County dog owners can purchase a 2019 dog license at the County Treasurer's Office, [online](#) now, or at a county agent office beginning in January.

Pennsylvania State Law requires all dogs 3 months and older to be licensed on a calendar year basis. Dog License fees are \$8.50 for a productive dog and \$6.50 if neutered or spayed.

For individuals 65 and older or persons with a disability, the cost is \$6.50 for a productive dog and \$4.50 if spayed or neutered. Disabled persons must show one of the following to receive the discount; disability insurance income under the Social Security Act, rent or property tax rebates under Public Law 104, or a handicapped license plate or placard issued by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

A Lifetime Dog License is also an option for a cost of \$51.50 if productive, and \$31.50 if spayed or neutered, and \$31.50 and \$21.50 for senior citizen and disability applicants. Lifetime Licenses are only available at the Cumberland County Treasurer's Office. To be eligible for a Lifetime License one must either have their pet tattooed or micro-chipped.

“A dog is more than just a pet, to many owners; a dog is a member of the family. To ensure their safety if they get lost, make sure your dog is licensed,” said Cumberland County Treasurer John Gross. “The value of a dog license is limitless and safeguards you and your canine friend.”

If a dog is lost, a license is an easy way for someone to identify your dog. Funding made available through Dog License sales helps to support animal shelters and outreach grants that promote responsible pet ownership programs provided through the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture. Compliance with state law is the personal responsibility of every dog owner, and should not be ignored.
