WOLF BRIDGE (CUMBERLAND COUNTY BRIDGE # C-11), OVER THE CONODOGUINET CREEK MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This proposed project involves the replacement of the existing, structurally deficient, and functionally obsolete Wolf Bridge over the Conodoguinet Creek in Middlesex Township, Cumberland County. The bridge is located on Wolfs Bridge Road, carrying approximately 2,200 vehicles daily. The existing structural deficiencies have resulted in the closure of the bridge in September of 2013.

More specifically, the safety and travel improvements include:

- Construction of a bridge that contains two full-width 12-foot lanes with 4-foot shoulders.
- The proposed bridge will be a non-load restricted bridge (i.e., no load posting).
- The Wolfs Bridge Road will generally follow the existing alignment and will improve sight distance and continuity.
- The existing Wolf Bridge is currently advertised by PennDOT to sell or give the bridge to an interested party. If the bridge is unsolicited, it will be demolished as part of this project.

TRAFFIC CONTROL

Long-term detours will be utilized while the new bridge is constructed. The first detour will be similar to the current detour implemented as part of the bridge closure. This detour will be necessary for construction of the bridge itself. The second detour will utilize W. Middlesex Road for the reconstruction of the intersection between Wolfs Bridge Road and Clemson Drive.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

- Design Completion: July 2019
- Bid Opening: August 2019
- Construction: November 2019 to November 2020

FUNDING & COST

- Construction cost estimate: \$2.64 million.
- Funding:
 - 80% Federal Funds
 - 25% State Funds
 - 5% County Funds
