Cumberland County Courts Warn of Fraudulent Calls for Arrest Warrants

Carlisle PA – The Cumberland County Courts have reported that residents have contacted them about receiving fraudulent phone calls requesting money. The caller states that there is “a warrant out for their arrest for failing to appear for jury duty”, and are purported to be from the Cumberland County Sheriff’s Department or a Cumberland County Constable. These calls are scams.

The Cumberland County Courts do not issue warrants in this manner without an initial court hearing. In addition, we do not ask for money over the phone.

The Cumberland County Courts and the Sheriff’s Office recommends that if a citizen receives a call, they should not under any circumstances give out personal or bank information, social security numbers, deposit a check or wire money to the caller.

If residents receive calls of this nature, they should contact their local police departments.
