### **Cumberland County's Conservation District 42<sup>nd</sup> Seedling Sale**

**Carlisle, PA** – Forty-two years and more than 500,000 seedlings sold, our environment is the big winner in the Cumberland County Conservation District's Annual Tree Seedling Sale, set for Thursday, April 25, 1-5 p.m. and Friday, April 26, 8 a.m. – 2 p.m. at the Conservation District Building 310 Allen Road, Carlisle.

Tree seedlings available for 2019 include:

- White pine, Canaan fir, Colorado blue spruce, Concolor fir, White oak, Red oak and American redbud.
- Golden Delicious, Enterprise and Initial apple trees
- Harrow Sweet and Bartlett and Montmorency Cherry pear trees.

Myrtle Clumps and a wildflower mix will be sold as well as tree shelters and wood stakes. Profits from the tree seedling sale will help offset costs associated with environmental education projects and natural resource-related programs in Cumberland County.
