Ford Named Cumberland County Deputy Chief Clerk

Carlisle, PA – Cumberland County Commissioners have named Florence Ford as the county’s deputy chief clerk.

Ford brings more than 15 years of municipal management experience to the position, including as Gettysburg Borough manager and Cumberland Township manager in Adams County as well as city administrator in Cheney, Kansas. Most recently, Ford worked as project finance specialist for the Gannett Fleming engineering firm in Camp Hill.

“I am very proud to be able to serve the citizens of Cumberland County,” said Ford. “I changed career paths and went back to school so I could work in government.”

Ford holds a master’s degree in public administration from Wichita State University, where she also earned her bachelor’s degree.

Ford will assist Chief Clerk Sandy Moyle with managing the county’s day-to-day operations within the guidelines set forth by the Pennsylvania County Code and the Board of Commissioners.

Moyle was promoted from deputy chief clerk to chief clerk in October.
