

Cumberland County Commissioners’ Finance Meeting Minutes

Call to Order: Commissioner DiFilippo called the meeting to order.

Topic for Discussion:

- **Bridge Replacement in Lower Mifflin Township – Kirk Stoner, Planning; Jake Fealtman, Roadmaster; Marcus McKnight, Solicitor - (See Attached)**

County Bridge program also inspects municipally owned bridges. Inspections are done by HRG, or an HRG sub-consultant. Harvey Road Bridge has been closed since June 2018. HRG worked with Lower Mifflin Township staff to develop initial cost assessments; Kirk provided different cost scenarios to the Commissioners. The township met with the Commissioners asking for any funding assistance from the county. The Township inquired about the funding for bridges the county receives from vehicle registrations. Commissioner Hertzler responded that the county is still working through County Bridge projects. Commissioner DiFilippo mentioned the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Bank for a low-interest loan as a possibility. Lower Mifflin Township staff will present different funding options to the Board of Commissioners at a later date.

- **Household Hazardous Waste Collection Events – Justin Miller, Recycling Coordinator – (See Attached)**

Follow up to a previous meeting held in November; concept of implementing a per pound fee for household hazardous waste events. Proposing three events: Thursday, July 18, 12-6; Saturday, August 17, 9-3; and Thursday, September 19, 12-6. Customer would need to schedule an appointment for drop off. Events are going to be held at the Electronic Recycling Center. Vendors will be onsite to package and haul waste away same day. IMTO has built a second program for Household Hazardous Waste. Anticipating a decrease in material due to the implementation of the per pound fee. Received a \$20,000 Sponsorship from Advanced Disposal for this event; continuing to look for additional sponsorships. Certificates of recognitions were given to sponsors after the previous hazardous waste collection event.
