### **Cumberland County 4-H Member Presented Rosemarie Peiffer Educational Award**

**Carlisle, PA** – The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners today presented Tucker Williams, a Cumberland County 4-H member, with the 2019 Rosemarie Peiffer 4-H Educational Award. Williams received the award for demonstrating personal growth and development through the 4-H program; holding leadership roles in 4-H and other organizations; and having established goals to continue his education and professional and personal growth.

Williams, a 2019 graduate of Big Spring High School, will attend Shippensburg University in the fall, and major in business. While attending college, Williams will enter his 10<sup>th</sup> year as a Cumberland County 4-H'er in the Horse and Pony Club. During his tenure, he has competed on quiz bowl teams, held several officer positions, earned numerous awards, and volunteered in his community.
