Cumberland County Looking For Agriculture Land Preservation Board Member

Carlisle, PA – The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners and the Agricultural Land Preservation Board are looking for interested individuals to fill a vacancy on the Agricultural Land Preservation Board.

Board members are responsible for overseeing the administration of the Cumberland County Agricultural Conservation Easement (*Farmland Preservation*) Program. Eligible candidates do not need to be active farmers, but should have a strong passion for agriculture and be Cumberland County residents for this volunteer, unpaid position.

The successful candidate would serve as an at-large member of the board and must be able to attend Agricultural Land Preservation Board meetings on the second Wednesday of every month at 7:30 a.m. The selected candidate will be appointed to fill a current vacancy, as well as, a new term of 3 years, beginning in January 2020.
