Cumberland County Libraries Closed for Staff Training on Wednesday, Oct. 30

Items will not be due on October 30; normal operating hours will resume at all locations on Thursday, Oct. 31

Mechanicsburg, PA – All public libraries in Cumberland County will be closed on Wednesday, Oct. 30, 2019, so that library staff may attend a continuing education event.

“Our Library staff will be attending annual training so they can stay up to date on essential skills that affect the way we serve our communities,” said Tara Major, public services training coordinator. “While our libraries are closed, online services such as the library catalog, research databases, eBooks, and our automated telephone circulation system will continue to be available.”

Items will not be due back on Wednesday, Oct. 30; however, if you choose to return items, locations have either outdoor return bins or depository slots to return items. Normal operating hours at all locations will resume Thursday, Oct. 31.
