



Cumberland County Prison Annual PREA Report for Calendar Year 2019

Cumberland County Prison is committed to operating in accordance with the Prison Rape Elimination Act's (PREA) promulgated national standards, in furtherance of the professionalization of staff and the sexual safety of individuals in our local custody.

For the calendar year 2019, there was one reported incident of inmate-on-inmate sexual abuse, and no reports of staff-on-inmate sexual abuse. The allegation of inmate-on-inmate sexual abuse was made by a third-party inmate. Managerial staff, who are trained in the performance of PREA investigations, conducted interviews and reviewed other available evidence, before concluding that the allegation of sexual abuse was "unfounded." The inmate who made the allegation was not subjected to any retaliatory adverse action for having presented the concern.

Since there were no "substantiated" or "unsubstantiated" findings of sexual abuse during the calendar year, the PREA Incident Review Committee did not assemble an annual report of recommendations to reduce potential future occurrences of sexual assault in Cumberland County Prison.

In 2019 Cumberland County Prison underwent their first PREA audit and therefore no comparison of trends is presented in this report.
