Orders Must Be received at the Conservation District Office By Monday, March 30

Carlisle, PA – Forty-three years and more than 500,000 seedlings sold, our environment is the big winner in the Cumberland County Conservation District's 43rd Annual Tree Seedling Sale, set for Thursday, April 16, 1-5 p.m. and Friday, April 17, 8 a.m. – 2 p.m. at the Conservation District Building 310 Allen Road, Carlisle.

Tree seedlings available for 2020 include:

- Colorado Blue Spruce
- Canadian Hemlock
- Concolor Fir
- Persimmon
- Scarlet Maple
- Swamp White Oak
- White Pine

The District is also offering three types of Apple Trees (Liberty, GoldRush & Initial), two Pear Trees (Harrow Sweet and Olympic) and Peach (Redhaven). Myrtle Clumps, wildflower mix, tree shelters and wood stakes are also available.

Profits from the tree seedling sale will help offset costs associated with environmental education projects and natural resource-related programs in Cumberland County.
