### Cumberland County Flags Flown at Half-Staff for Fallen Firefighter Jerome Guise

**Carlisle, PA** – The Cumberland County Commissioners ordered all county flags to be flown at half-staff over all county facilities and grounds in respect and memory of Firefighter Jerome Guise of Citizen's Fire Company No.1 of Mt. Holly Springs.

Firefighter Guise suffered fatal injuries while fighting a house fire in the 1500 block of Boiling Springs Road, Monroe Township, Cumberland County early Monday morning.

Jerome Guise was a 17-year veteran of the department. He is survived by his three young children, his mother, father and sister.

The Cumberland County flag shall be lowered until sunset Monday, March 23, 2020.
