Voted Mail-In and Absentee Ballots Must Be Taken To Bureau of Elections Office on Election Day

Carlisle, PA – Cumberland County residents, who are voting by Mail-In or Absentee Ballots for the Primary Election and have not mailed in their voted ballots through the United States Postal Service, must take the voted ballots to the Cumberland County Bureau of Elections Office, 1601 Ritner Highway, Suite 201 by Tuesday, June 2 at 8 p.m. Postmarks are not accepted.

“Mail-In and Absentee Ballots must be turned in at the Bureau of Elections Office, they cannot be dropped off at the polling places on Election Day” said Director of Elections, Bethany Salzarulo. “At the Bureau of Elections, we have secure ballot boxes in which you can drop off your voted ballots, and by law, residents can only hand-deliver their own ballot”

The secured ballot box is available in the lobby of the Cumberland County Bureau of Elections Office, on Monday, June 1, 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. and Primary Election Day, Tuesday, June 2, 7 a.m. - 8 p.m.
