Fourth Universal Testing at Claremont Nursing and Rehabilitation Center

Carlisle, PA – Claremont Nursing and Rehabilitation Center (CNRC) today announced a fourth round of universal testing for residents and staff will be conducted today, Friday, July 31 and Monday, Aug. 3.

There were no positive cases among the 212 residents and 300 staff tested for COVID 19 last week, however ten residents did refuse testing, and they are being monitored for any signs of the virus. The two residents and two staffers who tested positive in the second round of universal testing have recovered and the employees are back to work after 10 days of self-isolating.

To date, the total number COVID -19 cases remains at thirteen since the pandemic began. This includes eleven staffers and two residents.

Claremont has been working with officials from the Department of Health's Bureau of Laboratories, who have been supplying testing results. The National Guard, and the South Central Task Force Medical Reserve Corp and Claremont medical staff have been administering the testing.

Claremont continues to follow CDC and Pennsylvania Department of Health's COVID-19 guidelines for its residents and employees.
