COVID-19 Background

March 6, 2020 – Governor Wolf issued a Declaration of Disaster Emergency.

March 13, 2020 – President Trump issued a proclamation of Disaster Emergency

March 17, 2020 – Cumberland County Commissioners issued a Declaration of Emergency giving the county the ability to take immediate action in response to the pandemic.

March 27, 2020 – CARES Act was signed into law. Section 5001 of the CARES Act established the Coronavirus Relief Fund which offsets necessary expenditures incurred due to the COVID-19 public health emergency.

The Commissioners worked with local Chambers of Commerce, CAEDC, the Redevelopment Authority and others with a plan for response. The Commissioners named Gary Scicchitano as the COVID-19 Recovery Coordinator for Cumberland County.

May 29, 2020 – Act 24 of 2020 was signed by Governor Wolf. This legislation provided \$625 million in CARES Act coronavirus funding block grants for counties in the commonwealth through the Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED).

June 25, 2020 – Resolution 2020-20 COVID-19 Block Grant Program was approved by the Board of Commissioners. Cumberland County received \$22,881,555 in block grant funding.

The Renew Cumberland Task Force was created with the COVID-19 Recovery Coordinator as the lead. The task force includes representatives from CAEDC, Redevelopment Authority, and County Departments; Controller, Treasurer, Commissioner, Solicitor, Finance, Planning, Facilities, Public Safety, IMTO, Communications, and Drug & Alcohol.

The task force utilized experts to help develop the grant management process. This process includes, but is not limited to; defining priorities, grant application development, marketing, application review and funding recommendation, grant administration, and processing. The goal of Renew Cumberland is to assist the most entities with eligible funding areas that have the greatest need but have limited opportunity for other CARES Act funding.

Application and Application Portal Development

Under the umbrella of Renew Cumberland, a Renew Cumberland page was added to the county website. This page became the application portal with applicants choosing to complete the small business application or the county application.

Small Business and Tourism Application

For applicants who selected small business/tourism, they were taken to the CAEDC application portal to apply. The County contracted with CAEDC to manage the small business/tourism grant application process. CAEDC contracted with a vendor to develop the small business/tourism applications and supporting data management tools.

County Application

County Application was developed by the Cumberland County IMTO department. It was used by county departments, municipalities, non-profit agencies, and behavioral health providers. All applications were downloaded automatically to an access database.

Application Receipt, Summary, and Review

Once applications were received, the applications were available to the task force and review teams. Each group met and developed their recommendation to the Commissioners based on the scoring criteria as defined in each funding category summary. Gary Scicchitano, COVID-19 Recovery Coordinator, provided coordination, oversight, and assured all review teams met their required timeline, all of compliance questions were answered, and overall the Task Force met the objectives of the grant.

Initial Briefing

Once the application portal closed, all teams worked together to begin scoring applications and prepare an initial briefing for the Board of Commissioners. The briefing, on Wednesday, August 5, 2020, included the raw number of applications by category and included the amount requested in each category. The raw numbers included all applications regardless of eligibility. The task force presented a recommendation for funding categories based on the preliminary review of applications. A motion was passed to set the funding categories based on the preliminary findings.

Application Summary and Award Recommendations

During the next two weeks, the task force review teams reviewed the applications by category as assigned and in accordance with the specified criteria. All reviewers had access to the applications and were expected to review them in detail before each group discussion. Each team then met and developed their recommendations of application awards and funding. On

Friday, August 14 and Monday, August 17, 2020, the task force discussed their specific categorical findings and worked as a group to develop a funding/application recommendation for the Board of Commissioners. The Task Force has been scheduled to present these findings and recommendations at the Finance Meeting on Wednesday, August 19, 2020.

The Task Force is available for additional questions from the Commissioners before a final decision is made. The members of the Task Force plan to attend each Finance Meeting and Commissioner Workshop until the application awards are approved.

Proposed Second Phase for Small Business Grants

The parameters of the small business grant were \$5,000 to \$50,000 based on request and/or eligibility. There were 57 small business applicants who either requested less or were deemed eligible for less than \$5,000. The Task Force reviewed the funding categories on August 14, 2020 and recommends a second phase to solicit applications from small businesses who might be eligible for less than \$5,000 of funding.

The second application period could open within the next ten days of approval and remain open for two weeks. The same application and application portal would be used for the second phase. If the other funding categories are approved and there is a desire to proceed with a second phase, there would be \$418,227.27 available for this additional funding category.

Applicant Approval/Denial

Final approval is anticipated on or before Wednesday, August 26, 2020. Grant award letters will be sent to all of the approved grantees. The award letters include instructions for next steps and include the contract and other required information.

It is important to note that this is a federal grant and the grantee is responsible for meeting all federal requirements including meeting all reporting and audit requirements. Denial letters will be sent to all applicants that were not provided with a grant. The County will manage emailing all approvals and denials to the appropriate applicants.

County Departments will be contacted with approvals and denials through a separate process.

Contracts and Internal Processing of Checks

Once the award recommendations have been approved by the Board of Commissioners, contracts will be prepared. The contracts will formalize the relationship between the County and the award recipients. It will also outline all award recipient requirements.

Small Business and Tourism Grants

CAEDC will affirm that the small businesses are eligible to receive funding. They will also gather the signed contracts from the small businesses and will forward them to Finance within one week of receipt of the signed contract. CAEDC will also ensure all required documentation is completed and will dialogue with small businesses as needed.

Other Funding Category Grants

Contracts for all other funding categories will be prepared by the County and emailed to approved grantees. Grantees will return their signed contract and all other required documentations directly to Finance. Finance will assure the “grant awardee packet” is complete; signed contract, W-9, and other required documentation, but may request help from other departments to process the grants in a timely manner. Finance will ensure the non-business grants are not on the federal exclusion lists. All internal controls will be followed in processing grant awards. The additional tasks to be completed are:

- Systematic vendor check
- Clear review to look for fraudulent vendor (all fraudulent applications will reported to law enforcement)
- Adding vendor to Lawson
- Provide new vendor list and W-9 to the Controller for 1099 purposes
- Send contracts to Commissioners’ Office for approval
- Upload Contract Process completed by the Finance and the Solicitor’s Offices.

- Finance, or their designee, will prepare AP voucher packet when appropriate. Vouchers may be completed via upload or standard voucher.
 - **Small Businesses/Tourism:** Business and tourism grant awards will be processed after submission of packet from CAEDC. They have met the requirements at the point of grant award. Sub-recipient monitoring is completed by CAEDC by the determination of eligibility through the grant review process.
 - **Non-profit and Behavioral Health Agencies:** Non-profit and behavioral health agencies will be required to submit the grant reporting spreadsheet and certify that they have met all the requirements of the grant. Finance will prepare vouchers as necessary documentation is received. All non-profit and behavioral health agencies will need to submit single audits if they have received \$750,000 or more in federal funding in 2020.
 - **Municipalities:** Vouchers prepared as necessary documentation is provided.
 - **County Departments:** Charges will be expended from the County CARES fund or funds will be transferred from the CARES fund to the applicable fund.
- The Controller will add 1099 tax information to the vendor record and will include CARES Act checks on both the normal check runs and the off-week check runs.

Sub-Recipient Monitoring

The County is going to meet its sub-recipient monitoring requirements in the following manner.

Small Businesses and Tourism

The application process is considered the monitoring process. All applicants were fully vetted to meet the grant requirements before awards are approved and paid.

Non-Profit and Behavioral Health Agencies

Non-profit agencies and behavioral health agencies will be required to complete a funding report that certifies that they are requesting reimbursement for eligible uses of the CARES Act. If appropriate, a single audit will be requested and the County will review for program specific findings and address as necessary.

Municipalities

Funding will not be provided until supplies are received and/or project expenses have been incurred. If appropriate, a single audit will be requested and the County will review for program specific findings and address if necessary.

Reporting

The County will continue to utilize all of its systematic internal controls. The processing groups worked together to ensure that internal controls and segregation of duties remain in place. Finance will submit the state reporting as required.

- Awardees will be required to submit completion of project reports to Finance beginning the period of September 2020 due October 10.
- In the event that additional funding becomes available, Finance will compile and track additional allowable expenses that are not part of our current grant awardees.

Schedule of Federal Awards – The CARES Act funding will be included in our federal funding

Additional Potential Funding and/or Unspent Funds

There is the potential that the DCED may allocate additional funding to the County on December 1 and/or some awardees may not utilize all of their approved funding. All of the requirements will still apply to this funding including the timeframe for spending.

In order to prepare for the event of the additional funding and the short time frame or grant conclusion the following will be completed:

- Finance will track eligible expenditures of the County that are being funded by general County revenues.
- The Task Force will compile a list of denied applications that are eligible but were not provided the full eligible allocation.

Interest Earnings

The CARES Act funding was deposited into the County General Fund. Currently we are earning a very low interest rate and expect less than \$25,000 in earning. The County will estimate interest earnings and apply those earnings to the grant allocations.

Small Business Grant – Funding Decision Basis

Administered by Cumberland Area Economic Development Corporation (CAEDC)

The Renew Cumberland Small Business Grant (RCSBG) was developed to distribute funds from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act to small businesses with fewer than 100 employees. The Application criteria requested in the Application Form provided the Review Team with valuable data by which formulaic rating and ranking was achieved.

Assuming there would be \$10M available for distribution to small businesses, two ranking models were developed to determine how best to distribute the funds, the Risk Rating Model (A) and the Total Employment Impact (TEI) Model (B).

Risk Rating - (Model A)

There were seven criteria that went into developing a Risk Rating, see Table 1. The Review Team weighted the Criteria (w.%) based on the importance of that criteria in evaluating the applications.

Table 2 shows an example of the input data and the Weighted Risk Rating. The weighting factors from Table 1 were applied to the input data from each application to determine the Weighted Risk Rating.

Model A is weighted to better support businesses with fewer employees and supports diversity of business size throughout our economy.

Total Employment Impact (TEI) - (Model B)

The second model consisted of the Total Employment Impact (TEI), a scenario that is a way of looking at economic impact of the applicant, based on employee count and industry. The TEI Model (B) favors businesses with more employees and having a larger economic impact. Using the Industry (based on NAICS code) and the number of full time employees, a TEI value was determined for each application. The TEI/Grant \$ evaluates the impact that the grant dollars could have on the community.

Grant Review Process

The review process included CAEDC staff (to review the applications for completeness and eligibility), the County Chambers of Commerce (support during the application process, review applications and provide input relative to businesses), and a Review Team to review the criteria and determine how best to distribute funds based on the criteria and desired community impacts.

The Chambers were engaged multiple times before, during and after the application process was complete, meeting at least 5 times via zoom calls or in person. The Review Team met to do an initial review of the criteria and data analysis process, and met three times to discuss the data, review eligibility of applications that were flagged by staff for further review, develop funding distribution recommendations, and make a recommendation of applications to be funded to the Renew Cumberland Task Force. CAEDC, the Chambers, and the Review Team are confident in the process and the recommendation to fund applications based on the intent of the Small Business Grant Program as directed by Cumberland County.

Funding Recommendation

Upon review of the grant recommendations with the Renew Cumberland Task Force, it was determined that approximately \$13,015,099 would be available for the Small Business Grant. With the addition of \$3.M of funding (original planning amount was \$10M) to the small business grant program, there are sufficient funds to award grants to all eligible applicants at or near their eligible level in the amount of \$13,015,099.

Review of applications

First review - Monday, August 3: Committee discussed scoring criteria and made recommendations for funding buckets. We reviewed the applications for eligibility and/or duplication.

Two applications were removed before recommending the funding buckets to Commissioners. These applications were a project previously rejected by Commissioners and duplicate laptop applications.

The subcommittee reviewed applications and submitted scores in the application database.

- 1 = No
- 3 = maybe; review for discussion
- 5 = Yes

Second meeting - Monday, August 10: Discussion of all applications that were scored with a 1 or 3. Open discussion included all aspects of the application. Most were either denied or approved during this meeting. The applications details were reviewed for eligibility, duplication, expected completion time, etc. The Contingency applications are backed with actual eligible expenses. The committee requested additional explanation from Department Heads who still had outstanding applications.

Third Meeting - Wednesday, August 12: Discussion of the outstanding applications with the subcommittee and department head if needed. Final recommendations were determined by the group.

Review Process

- Zoom meeting held on July 17 to discuss program guidelines and requirements with municipal applicants.
- Applications reviewed by a committee of 4 people: Kirk Stoner, Bob Shively, Stephanie Williams, and Elizabeth Grant
- The variety of communities and funding request types made a numeric scoring/evaluation system impractical, thus, evaluation factors were more qualitative.
- Evaluation factors included:
 - Does the application propose an eligible use? Funding may only be used for costs that:
 - Are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID–19);
 - Was not accounted for in the budget, most recently approved as of March 27, 2020 (the date of enactment of the CARES Act) for the State or government;
 - Were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020, and ends on December 30, 2020; and
 - Are consistent with guidance provided by the US Treasury Department or PA Department of Community and Economic Development
 - Community benefit as discussed in the application.

- Financial need as discussed in the application.
 - Availability of other funding sources for the proposed expenditure
- After reviewing the applications, the committee members inputted a recommended level of funding for each line item of funding requested by municipality.
- Committee members met to discuss individual funding recommendations and explore funding options to meet the allocated amount of \$850,000.
- Funding options were developed and reviewed by the committee members.
- Requests recommended for no funding or funding less than requested were noted and a rationale for the decision included.
- Requests were grouped into 8 categories of requests (see above).
- Committee reached a consensus on proposed awards of \$821,328.73.
- The recommended funding level as a percentage of the 2020 budget and the per capita request of the recommended funding level was provided to provide context for each municipality.



Nonprofit and Behavioral Health Subcommittee

Subcommittee members included Kelly Neiderer, Cumberland County Treasurer; Tim Whelan, Executive Director of the Cumberland County Housing and Redevelopment Authorities; and Jack Carroll, Executive Director of the Cumberland-Perry Drug and Alcohol Commission.

Review Process:

A standard review form was developed. (See copy attached.) Key criteria included:

- Use of funds for eligible purposes
- Benefit to Cumberland County residents
- Applicant's connection to Cumberland County
- Was the funding request reasonable
- Applicant expertise and capacity
- Convincing need for funds articulated
- Completeness of application

Each of the subcommittee members completed a review scoresheet for each of the applications that were submitted. We received a **total of 114 applications from nonprofit agencies and 6 applications from behavioral health providers.**

The subcommittee conducted four work sessions in which we compared individual scores for each of the 120 applicants, calculated average scores and generated funding recommendations. The total meeting time for these work session exceeded 10 hours.

A list was generated for each group of applicants (nonprofit organizations and behavioral health agencies) summarizing the amount requested and the recommended funding award. A reason was identified for those applicants not recommended to receive any funding. For those recommended to receive funds, a brief note of how the funds will be used was listed.

COVID-19 relief funding that is awarded to non-profit and behavioral health agencies will be used for one or more of the following purposes:

- PPE and/or Sanitizing Supplies
- Increased Cost to Comply with CDC Guidelines
- Hazard Pay
- Increased Demand/Need for Services including Expanded Childcare
- Expenditure Reimbursement Due to Operation Interruption
