Pollution Control Project Funded in Cumberland County

29 County Conservation Districts Received Funding to Promote Water Pollution Prevention Strategies across PA

Carlisle, PA – The Cumberland County Conservation District received \$1,310 in grant funding to provide a “Homeowner’s Guide to Stormwater” at Rain Garden Workshops. The guide will help residents capture and infiltrate water from storm events from leaving their property.

“The project funded through this mini-grant program will reach many of our county’s residents,” said Lori Glace, conservation analyst. “Our Conservation District officials will continue to educate a variety of audiences on actions they can take every day to make a difference for future generations.”

The Cumberland County Conservation District partnered with Upper Allen Township, Penn State Extension, and Penn State Extension Master Watershed Stewards to begin the education and outreach regarding the projects that residents should begin by March 2021.

Forty-one projects will be funded in twenty-nine of the state’s counties. Projects include agricultural field days, streamside landowner workshops, forestry workshops, homeowner workshops, and more. View complete listing of awarded projects, visit [PACD](#).
