County Retains Company to Evaluate Potential Buyers for Claremont Nursing and Rehabilitation Center

Carlisle, PA – The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners today announced the hiring of a financial and advisory firm to evaluate the potential sale of Claremont Nursing Rehabilitation Center (CNRC). Susquehanna Group Advisors, Inc., a Harrisburg based company, will assist the county in evaluating potential purchasers for the county-owned facility at 1000 Claremont Road, Carlisle.

“After careful review and consideration of our options to continue providing skilled nursing care to the residents of Cumberland County, we have determined to explore the possibility of transferring ownership and operations to a private operator,” said Cumberland County Commissioner Gary Eichelberger.

This process will take several months to carefully evaluate potential operators and any offers the county might receive. The county expects to make a decision by the spring of 2021.

“Our primary objective is to ensure the long-term viability of Claremont, to continue to provide a high quality of care for our residents, and a positive work environment for our employees,” said Commissioner Jean Foschi.

“We will evaluate any interested entity first and foremost on their track record of providing skilled healthcare, their commitment to the residents and the employees of Claremont,” said Commissioner Vince DiFilippo.

Claremont Nursing and Rehabilitation Center is a 282-bed skilled nursing facility providing state-of-the-art therapeutic nursing care for a variety of needs. Claremont provides transitional care

and a full-time rehabilitation center and dementia unit. The facility was established in 1829. From 1967 to 1997, it was known as the Cumberland County Nursing Home and in 1997, the name was changed to Claremont Nursing and Rehabilitation Center.
