Cumberland County Residents Can Get Free Drive-Thru COVID-19 Tests

Carlisle, PA – Free COVID-19 testing is available for all Cumberland County residents **Thursday, Jan. 28 through Monday Feb. 1, 9 a.m. - 6 p.m., each day** at the U.S Army Heritage and Education Center. The pop-up testing is a partnership with the county, PA Department of Health, its provider AMI and the U.S. Army Heritage and Education Center.

Testing is available on a first-come, first-served basis, and registration is available on site. No appointments are necessary. Patients should be three and older, and do not need to have COVID-19 symptoms for testing. Residents are encouraged to bring a photo-ID or insurance card. Test results will be available two to seven days after testing.

Who: Ages 3 and older

Background: Mid-nasal passage swab PCR tests will be performed. Individuals who are tested should self-quarantine while they await test results. Individuals who test positive will receive a phone call from AMI while individuals who test negative will receive an email with a secured-PDF. Up to 450 patients can be tested per day.
