

Best Practices for Circulating Petitions

To mitigate the spread of COVID-19, you are encouraged to follow these recommendations when collecting signatures:

- If you host in-person events, adhere to the occupancy limits set forth in Governor Wolf's November 23rd [order](#), and enforce the use of face masks in accordance with the Pennsylvania Department of Health (DOH) [Updated Order Requiring Universal Face Coverings](#).
- If you circulate door-to-door, wear a mask when you are in proximity to other people, including when you approach someone's home and interact with voters outdoors.
- Maintain a distance of at least 6 feet from others, even when wearing a mask, in accordance with [CDC guidance](#) and the [DOH order](#) mentioned above.
- Consider providing a fresh petition page to each signer and asking signers to use their own pen to minimize contact with shared surfaces.
- Consider providing hand sanitizer and sanitizing wipes to promote hand hygiene.
- Clean shared surfaces, such as clip boards and pens, between each use.
- If a signer asks you to leave a petition page with them to sign on their own, you may do so as long as it is a blank petition page and the signer also completes the statement of circulator on the back of the petition page.
