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Commissioners Approve 2021-2022 Fiscal Budget

Carlisle, PA – The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners today approved the 2021-2022 Fiscal Budget. The total revenue in the fiscal budget is \$57,865,075 which predominantly consists of Human Services funding.

The fiscal budget is primarily funded by grants from state and federal sources which cover 79% of the budget, or \$45,896,488. County subsidy and additional funding sources cover the remaining 21% of the budget.

In addition to the fiscal budget that was approved; there is the calendar budget which includes the general fund, nursing home, public safety, and several other funds. The calendar budget is normally approved in early December.

The Cumberland County Fiscal Budget was approved during the Tuesday, June 1, 2021 Board of Commissioners meeting at 2 p.m.
