Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) Grant Program

Provides 75% support to local municipalities as they initiate projects that reduce the risks associated with hazards.

Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA) Grant Program

Provides 75% federal cost share for flood mitigation projects identified in the County Hazard Mitigation Plan.

Community Rating System (CRS)

This program offers reduced flood insurance premiums for municipalities that exceed floodplain management practices found in the NFIP.
