Call to Order: Commissioner Eichelberger called the meeting to order.

Public Comment: None.

Approval of Minutes: Commissioner DiFilippo made a motion to approve the March 23, 2022 meeting minutes. Commissioner Foschi seconded the motion and it unanimously carried.

Topics of Discussion:

Mental Health Budget – Projected Deficit Discussion: Annie Strite explained the Mental Health Budget and the projected deficit. She provided information as to the number of individuals receiving County base funding for Mental Health Services. Annie also provided the state allocation trend for Cumberland and Perry Counties. She reported the Crisis Intervention numbers had increases in the 302 petitions, in mobile crisis responses, and police involved responses. She said the 9-1-1 calls coded as Mental Health has increased. She expressed concern as to the lack of staff and the overwhelming caseloads. More discussion ensued regarding concerns for programs and the possibility of budget cuts.

Discussion and Approval of the F&M Trust Resolution to give Stacy Snyder, Dana Best, and Ron Snow Authorization over the CNRC Resident Trust Fund Account **Action Requested*

Ron Snow explained the authorization of the F&M Trust resolution is for Stacy Snyder, Dana Best, and Ron Snow to have permission to sign checks, as there are still funds coming into this active account carried over from the CNRC Resident Trust Fund account.
